
## BRAMHAM GARDENS



## Standard Conditions Applying to Private Parties & Barbecues within these Gardens

The following guidelines (amended in the light of the recently adopted draft Bye-Laws) apply to all private picnics, parties and barbecues – whether using the Committee's permanent structure in the north-east corner or personal portable apparatus of all kinds.

## On all occasions, the member(s) convening the party must:

- 1. Obtain the Committee's prior consent via email (<u>info@bramhamgardens.org</u>) to any proposed party of more than TEN (10) persons (including both adults and children);
- 2. Accept full responsibility for ensuring that their guests fully observe the Bye-Laws at all times;
- 3. Not allow gates to be left ajar but open and close them as guests arrive and leave;
- 4. Ensure that any items of garden furniture moved for the purpose of the party are carried, *not* dragged and subsequently returned to their original locations;
- 5. Ensure that all litter created by the party is removed from the Garden;
- 6. Ensure that no dogs other than those already registered with the Committee are admitted within the Garden enclosure:
- 7. Music, tents or large items such as bouncy castles etc., are strictly prohibited.

## Concerning barbecues:

- 1. All portables barbecues must be sited on the gravel paths and *NOT* on any part of the lawn. Once lit, they must never be left unattended;
- 2. Please be considerate of the residents in flats with access to the Garden;
- 3. After the barbecue has finished, hot charcoal residues must not in any circumstances be left or tipped in the Gardens. These must be removed along with all other party litter. The only exception to this is if the Committee's facility is used, in which case the spent fuel can be left to cool and removed the following morning
